Get a unique, behind-the-scenes look at state government by serving as an intern for a state representative.

The House Republican Leadership Office is currently seeking interns to help Republican representatives during the 2018 Colorado General Assembly legislative session. Internships will likely begin in early January and will last until May 2018.

Our internships can be a memorable part of your undergraduate or graduate experience, and are perfect for students interested in political science, public policy, journalism, communications or related fields of study.

Our most successful interns are those who enjoy working with people and are familiar with at least basic word processing programs.

Duties typically include:

- assisting legislators with telephone calls, e-mails and office visits;
- constituent services;
- attending legislative hearings and meetings;
- conducting internet and legislative research;
- drafting official letters;
- social media posting; and
- tracking legislation.

Interns may also assist legislators with a variety of other projects as needed.

Our internships are not paid, but offer valuable work experience, networking opportunities and exposure to the political process in Colorado. Interns are typically asked to work 15-20 hours per week.

Our office is located at the Colorado State Capitol.
